Sullivan succeeds with simplicity in his originally self-published epic fantasy debut. Hadrian Blackwater and Royce Melborn are a pair of thieves and mercenaries. They aren't mentioned in any prophecies or the lost heirs to anything; they're just criminals who happen to have hearts of gold. Going by the inexplicably pretentious shared name of "Riyria," they steal incriminating letters from a blackmailer, kidnap a young king to save his life, and protect a village menaced by a terrible monster. Along the way, they meet a clever princess, an unlucky monk, a 1,000-year-old wizard with no hands, and a naïve but heroic farm girl. There's even the beginning of a series story arc as the powerful Church of Nyphron secretly schemes to control the world. From the Author

In October 2010, I released *Wintertide*, the fifth book of my *Riyria Revelations*. At the time I had been selling modestly well for a self-published author (1,000 books a month spread across 4 titles), and with the release of the fifth book, I saw a significant spike in sales. Thinking I had taken the series as far as I could, I thought the only way to achieve any "real success" was to attract the attention of a larger publisher. To be honest, I thought it would have taken six to eighteen months and by then *Percepliquis*, (the sixth and final book) would have already been released). Imagine my surprise when multiple publishers expressed an interest in just a few weeks and a pre-emptive bid was made by Orbit (fantasy imprint of big-six publisher Hachette Book Group).

Orbit had many convincing arguments for re-releasing the series as a trilogy (with two books in each omnibus edition). But this would be a problem for existing fans of the series. First, they would have to wait an additional 9 months for *Percepliquis*, but they would also have to re-buy the fifth book due to the new bundle. There was not much that could be done about the delay, but fortunately Orbit was willing to do the extra work to release the book in its original format, so existing fans of the series could complete their

collections. A decision I was very pleased with, and proved to me that Orbit was the right choice for the series.

Unfortunately this had led to a bit of confusion. The only bad reviews I've received for *Percepliquis* (and *Heir of Novron*) is from people who bought both books. Despite mine and the publisher's efforts, some people were confused. For this I'm sorry...and hope you can return your duplicate books for a refund. To try to prevent others from making the same mistake let me try to clarify the issue.

- If you have read *Wintertide*, then you should purchase *Percepliquis* only. There is no need to buy *Heir of Novron* as you already have both books that it is comprised of.
- If you have read *The Emerald Storm*, then you should purchase *Heir of Novron* only. There is no need to buy *Percepliquis* as it is already contained in the larger *Heir of Novron* book.
- If you have read *The Rise of Empire*, then you should purchase *Heir of Novron* only. There is no need to buy *Percepliquis* as it is already contained in the larger *Heir of Novron* book.

Again, I'm sorry for any confusion on the part of readers for putting this book out two different ways. It was not, as some have suggested, some ploy by myself or the publisher to get more sales. What we were trying to do is provide existing fans a way to complete their series. And once again I'd like to thank Orbit for the time and effort to they took to put the books out two different ways.

About the Author

Michael J. Sullivan has been successfully published in all three publication paths: small press, self-published, and traditional (big-six). His debut series, *The Riyria Revelations* has sold 70,000 copies when self-published and combined with his traditionally published sales is now over 265,000 as of mid 2013. The series has also been translated to thirteen foreign languages including: German, Dutch, French, and Japanese.

Michael's work has been well received by critics and readers alike, earning him hundreds of positive reviews, and more than 50 "best of" or "most anticipated" list mentions. He has attributed much of his success to the fantasy book blogging community.
